1. WELCOME/APOLOGIES

Chair Breuer opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
Apologies - E. McFarlane.

2. PRESENTATIONS

Rob Hancock – expression of interest in placing an Andamooka-related advertisement in Flinders Ranges & Outback magazine for 2016. General discussion and agreement to investigate the idea further.

3. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

4. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Minutes of the previous meeting held 31st August 2015 were circulated to all attendees.

5. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

- CCS Debt Collection – Member Gough reported that the District Court had, on October 27th, dismissed the application by some debtors to have the Magistrate's decision set aside. The normal debt collection process can now continue. The OCA, through Chair Woolford has issued a media release to that effect which is available on the OCA web site.
- RJCP – Member Hancock reported that progress on negotiation of a new contract for 15/16 has stalled and APOMA are still waiting on Complete Personnel to produce a contract for the ongoing program. It is hoped that this can be resolved in the near future. Mark Shirley (OCA) has contacts within Complete Personnel and will make some enquiries to assist APOMA. Matter to be reviewed at the next ATMC meeting.
- ATMC (OCA) staffing – Member Gough reported that staffing issues have been resolved. Town overseer has been contracted for 12 months effective 1/11/2015.. Any municipal issues recognised by APOMA/community should be referred to Mark Brown in the first instance, and he should also be the contact point for OCA contractors. Mark will then liaise with Stephen as needed.



- Andamooka dump – Roxby dump closure - Member Gough reported that contact has been made with the EPA with regard to erecting signage at the dump. Waiting on advice from the EPA.
- Borefield Road realignment – ongoing discussion between stakeholders – review at next ATMC meeting.
- APOMA representatives on ATMC – has been resolved – Members Hancock and Musolino to continue until 30/6/2016 at this stage.

6. CHAIR'S REPORT

- Frontier Services – a tender has been released for interested parties to consider regarding continued service in Andamooka (and other areas). Andamooka meeting 27/11/15 of stakeholders to discuss the situation. Chair Breuer, Members Hancock and Musolino and Stefan Bilka are intending to attend. A letter of concern and support for continued service will be sent to Minister Jack Snelling prior to that meeting.

7. MEMBER'S REPORT

- Member Gough – EFTPOS facility for the ATMC office – still under review considering the cost effectiveness.
- NRM Arid Lands levy payment options for locals – still being considered by NRM.
- Mines Department closure and service relocation to ATMC office – ongoing discussions with Peter Lane – review at next ATMC meeting.

8. TOWN OVERSEER'S REPORT

- Boundaries of the job are more clearly understood after recent discussions between OCA and APOMA and TO.
- Office hours (open to the public) recently changed to 8:30 am to 1:30 pm. Seems to be working well. No complaints since the change.

9. ATMC BUSINESS

- Community hall air conditioning – Mark Brown is currently getting quotes to repair/upgrade/replace the system. He will report to APOMA and ATMC once more information is to hand.
- Road re-sheeting – Member Gough reported that discussions are ongoing with DPTI and that further funding may become available to re-sheet some roads. Members Hancock and Musolino to discuss with Andrew Collins which roads he recommends. A DPTI representative will be invited to attend the next ATMC meeting for further discussions on roads.
- ATMC budget and business plan – ongoing issue for ATMC to produce future budgets and business plans. ATMC working group will meet in Andamooka on 2/12/15 to begin work on the next budget and business plan. Mark Shirley, Mark Brown will also attend. Budget and Business Plan for 2016/17 needs to be ready for consultation in April 2016, with first draft ready mid-late January.



- Pastoral access – Member Gough reported that there are no exclusions areas locally in relation to the Indigenous Land Use Agreement with Kokatha, any restrictions to access are pastoral lease-based. This issue is under review between various agencies. Member Gough recommended that if people are being excluded locally then detailed, accurate information should be obtained of the exclusion and passed on to the OCA office.
- Surveyed blocks – Member Gough reported that under the ILUA 12 blocks were offered up on the north-western edge of town and that at some point those blocks will be surveyed and titled.
- Community hall – cleaning contract issues – Member Gough is currently in discussion with the Contractor (Outback Landscaping) about the terms of the contract. To be reviewed next meeting.


