

Leigh Creek Township Update

July 2018 – Reporting maintenance

Landlords and tenants share the responsibility for repairs and maintenance in residential rental properties. When any maintenance or repairs are needed tenants must ask the landlord to fix the problem. The request can be made by phone, email or by letter.

If the repair is needed urgently (e.g. burst water pipe) every effort should be made to contact the landlord as soon as possible. The landlord is not required to give notice to the tenant to enter the premises in an emergency.
