6.2 Sale of Land for Non Payment of Rates (Ref, N19-01/02)

In 2012 following consultation with the Andamooka Progress and Opal Miners Association Inc. and the wider Andamooka community the OCA applied a community contribution on rateable land in the Andamooka area to raise funds to assist in the provision of municipal services in the township. All attempts to recover an outstanding debt relating to Allotment 579 located in Andamooka have been to no avail.

Under provisions of section 184 of the *Local Government Act 1999* the OCA may take steps to sell land where rates are in arrears for three years or more, relevant to Allotment 579 in Andamooka.
