Financial Plan And Community Affairs Resourcing And Management Agreement out for consultation

Iron Knob Progress Association (IKPA) has formally sought the assistance of the Outback Communities Authority (OCA) in the day-to-day administration of the Association's affairs due to the increasing demand on the community volunteers.

The IKPA has endorsed the application of a Community Contribution Scheme as a mechanism for equitable cost sharing for the delivery of services provided by the IKPA for the benefit of the whole community.

In response, the OCA has developed an administrative model that includes a Community Contribution Scheme for the Iron Knob community.

OCA Chair Ms Cecilia Woolford said: "The OCA is now looking for community feedback on a proposed Financial Plan, Budget and Community Affairs Resourcing & Management (CARM) agreement in accordance with the OCA's public consultation policy."

"The Authority acknowledges the tremendous work undertaken by community volunteers and recognises the challenges they face".

Consultation on the proposed Financial Plan, Budget and CARM will commence on Monday 14 October 2013.
